

## Tracheostomy care: Methods of care SUMMARY

# Tracheostoma skin care, changing the tracheostomy dressing, changing the inner cannula of a tracheostomy (if present)

- 1. Anticipate
- 2. Prepare
- 3. Proceed
- 4. Prepare material required
- 5. Position your child
- 6. Suction tracheobronchial secretions, if needed
- 7. Untie or loosen the tracheostomy ties, if needed
- 8. Remove the dressing, if in place
- 9. Examine the skin around the tracheostomy and under the tracheal cannula flanges
- 10. Clean the skin around the tracheostomy
- 11. Dry the skin around the tracheostomy
- 12. Place a dressing around the tracheostomy, if required
- 13. Adjust the tension of the tracheostomy ties
- 14. Replace the inner cannula (if tracheal cannula with 2 parts)
- 15. Clean and store the re-usable inner cannula
- 16. Recover

#### Changing the tracheostomy ties

- 1. Anticipate
- 2. Prepare
- 3. Proceed
- 4. Prepare the material
- 5. Position your child
- 6. Suction tracheobronchial secretions, if needed
- 7. Secure the cannula in place
- 8. Detach one side of the Velcro<sup>®</sup> band (if this is the type of tie in place)
- 9. Examine the skin on the neck
- 10. Clean and dry the skin on the neck
- 11. Insert a new Velcro® band
- 12. Adjust the tension of the new Velcro® band
- 13. Clean and store the soiled Velcro® band
- 14. Examine the skin of the neck under the soiled ribbons (if in place)
- 15. Clean and dry the skin of the neck
- 16. Double ribbon technique: insert the new ribbons
- 17. Double ribbon technique: attach the new ribbons together
- 18. Single ribbon technique: insert the new ribbon
- 19. Single ribbon technique: attach the new clean ribbon
- 20. Adjust the tension of the new ribbon
- 21. Remove the soiled ribbon
- 22. Recover



#### Changing of a simple tracheal cannula

- 1. Anticipate
- 2. Prepare
- 3. Proceed
- 4. Inspect the new cannula
- 5. Prepare the new cannula if so desired
- 6. Position your child
- 7. Suction tracheobronchial secretions if needed
- 8. Secure the tracheal cannula in place
- 9. Remove the old tracheostomy ties
- 10. Lubricate the new cannula, if not already done
- 11. Remove the old cannula
- 12. Start the insertion of the new cannula
- 13. Continue the insertion of the new cannula
- 14. Finish the insertion of the new cannula
- 15. Secure the cannula with tracheostomy ties
- 16. Verify the positioning of the new cannula
- 17. Adjust the tension of the tracheostomy ties
- 18. Clean the reusable cannula or discard the disposable cannula
- 19. Recover

#### Administration of medication via tracheostomy: by a small volume nebulizer

- 1. Anticipate
- 2. Prepare
- 3. Proceed
- 4. Prepare the medication
- 5. Add the medication to the nebulizer
- 6. Prepare the delivery system
- 7. Position your child
- 8. Suction tracheobronchial secretions, if needed
- 9. Turn the compressor on
- 10. Place the tracheal collar
- 11. Administer the medication
- 12. Suction tracheobronchial secretions, if needed
- 13. Clean and store the equipment
- 14. Recover

### Administration of medication via tracheostomy: by meter dose inhaler with a spacer

- 1. Anticipate
- 2. Prepare
- 3. Proceed
- 4. Prepare the medication
- 5. Position your child
- 6. Prepare the medication delivery system
- 7. Connect the spacer to the tracheal cannula connector
- 8. Administer the medication
- 9. Optimize entry of medication to the lungs
- 10. Repeat according to the prescribed dosage
- 11. Remove and store the equipment
- 12. Recover
