

Ventilatory assistance: Methods of care SUMMARY

Invasive ventilation

- 1. Anticipate
- 2. Prepare
- 3. Proceed
- 4. Prepare the device
- 5. Assemble the ventilation circuit
- 6. Prepare the heated humidifier, if being used
- 7. Prepare the artificial nose, if being used
- 8. Position and prepare your child
- 9. Inflate the cuffed tracheal cannula, if present
- 10. Turn on the device
- 11. Connect the circuit to the tracheal cannula
- 12. Continue and supervise ventilator assistance
- 13. Discontinue ventilation and disconnect the circuit from the tracheal cannula
- 14. Turn off the device
- 15. Deflate the cuffed tracheal cannula, if present
- 16. Replace the speaking valve or the artificial nose, if needed
- 17. Clean and store the equipment
- 18. Recover

Non-invasive ventilation with mask

- 1. Anticipate
- 2. Prepare
- 3. Proceed
- 4. Prepare your child to wear the mask
- 5. Prepare the device
- 6. Prepare the humidifier of the device
- 7. Assemble the ventilation circuit
- 8. Prepare the mask
- 9. Position and prepare your child
- 10. Install the mask
- 11. Turn on the device
- 12. Continue and supervise ventilatory assistance
- 13. Discontinue ventilation, remove the mask and close the device
- 14. Clean and store the equipment
- 15. Recover



Non-invasive ventilation with a mouthpiece

- 1. Anticipate
- 2. Prepare
- 3. Proceed
- 4. Prepare the device
- 5. Assemble the ventilation circuit
- 6. Prepare the mouthpiece
- 7. Position and prepare your child
- 8. Turn on the device
- 9. Position the mouthpiece and start ventilator assistance
- 10. Continue and supervise ventilatory assistance
- 11. Discontinue ventilation, remove the mouthpiece and turn off the device
- 12. Clean mouthpiece
- 13. Recover

Manual ventilation by tracheostomy

- 1. Anticipate
- 2. Prepare
- 3. Proceed
- 4. Prepare and verify the ventilatory bag
- 5. Position your child
- 6. Prepare your child
- 7. Inflate the cuffed tracheal cannula, if present
- 8. Connect the ventilatory bag to the tracheal cannula
- 9. Ventilate with the ventilatory bag
- 10. Disconnect the ventilatory bag from the tracheal cannula
- 11. Deflate the cuffed tracheal cannula, if present
- 12. Restart invasive ventilation, if needed
- 13. Replace the speaking valve or the artificial nose, if needed
- 14. Clean and store the equipment
- 15. Recover

Manual ventilation with mask

- 1. Anticipate
- 2. Prepare
- 3. Proceed
- 4. Prepare and verify the ventilatory bag
- 5. Prepare the mask for manual ventilation
- 6. Position your child
- 7. Prepare your child
- 8. Install the mask for manual ventilation
- 9. Ventilate with the ventilatory bag
- 10. Remove the mask
- 11. Restart the non-invasive ventilation, if needed
- 12. Clean and store the equipment
- 13. Recover
