Aspiration of oral secretions

- 1. Anticipate
- 2. Prepare
- 3. Proceed
- 4. Prepare material required
- 5. Set the pressure regulator of the suction device
- 6. Connect the suction catheter to the suction tubing
- 7. Position your child
- 8. Check the pressure level of the suction device and lubricate the catheter
- 9. Insert the catheter
- 10. Aspirate the secretions
- 11. Rinse the catheter
- 12. Repeat the aspiration as needed
- 13. Clean the catheter
- 14. Store the equipment
- 15. Recover
